PROGRESS ON DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

On taking over in March 2019, the new Managing Committee has undertaken a major development of Club facilities as seen by members who visit regularly. Significant details are enumerated in succeeding paragraphs for information of all esteemed members :-

- ◆ Banquet halls at the first floor have been upgraded by fixing designer tiles, new ACs and fans, curtains etc and their ambience have substantially been improved.
- ◆ Eight items of gym equipments including two treadmills and across trainer have been purchased and new flooring has been fixed in both parts of the Gym.
- ◆ Upgradation and maintenance of tennis courts have been accorded priority by solving rain water drainage problem and opening second entry gate at the centre.
- ◆ Elevator (Lift) is being installed for Elderly and Senior Citizens for travel to first floor.
- ◆ Washrooms/toilets have been upgraded by fixing/replacing quality taps/fittings.
- ◆ Storage facility is being created for catering department at the first floor for safe custody of catering stores.
- ◆ Old railings/grills along hedges are being replaced by new strong grills.
- ◆ MDF boards along with lighting system are being installed for beautification of verandahs.
- ◆ Website and online payment portals.

We wish to apprise the members that this development trend shall be continued as we are committed to take this Club to greater heights so that members can enjoy excellent ambience and friendly atmosphere.

Dear Fellow Members,

During the last three months, I attached considerable importance to significant issues to include further upgradation of facilities, review of Party and A-la-carte menu, purchase of new items for Gym and improve quality of entertainment. With the concerted efforts of our Chairman Catering Sub-committee, we have brought out an aesthetically designed A-la-carte menu which has been appreciated by members and their families. Efforts are being made to ensure better quality and variety of food and ensure quality service in all banquetting facilities.

I wish to share with members that minimum wages implemented by Govt of NCT of Delhi has substantially affected the Club and resulted in additional burden of 75 lakhs per annum. The Managing Committee has no option but to generate additional financial resources to meet the growing short fall of funds by marginal increase in monthly subscription and levy for promotion of cultural activities.

On entertainment front, our Entertainment Sub-committee is doing an excellent job by outsourcing new talents and showcasing reputed singers. I wish to highlight that all functions held between Apr and Jun 2019 (Baisakhi, musical evenings, rain dance) were well appreciated by members and their families.

I firmly believe in member satisfaction. There are many different things that contribute to a great membership experience to include clean washrooms/toilets, friendly catering service, well maintained facilities like Gym, Swimming Pool, Tennis Courts etc. Therefore, we are paying continuous attention to maintenance and house keeping aspects including regular pest control.

I am also re-affirming that there will be no compromise with the discipline and decorum of the Club. 

Non compliance of Guest Entry Policy. We wish to mention that members (not dependants) are welcome to bring their guests to the Club. They will be allowed entry only if accompanied by member who shall be liable for disciplinary

action, in case of any misbehaviour by Guests. As per policy, all guests have to be registered and payment of guest entry charges to be made as under:-

| No. of Guests | Charges per Guest (GST Extra) |
|--------------------|----------------------------------|
| (a) Upto 10 Guests | Rs-50/- |
| (b) 11-20 Guests | Rs-100/- |
| (c) 21-30 Guests | Rs-200/- |

Guest charges for other facilities such as Card Room, sports complex, swimming pool etc will be in addition to entry charges. Despite clear guest entry policy, a large number of members do not cooperate with the Club staff at the Reception Counter, which have not been appreciated by the Managing Committee.

Discipline and Maintenance of Decorum. Recent incidents involving some Card Room members have been a cause of concern and embarrassment. The Managing Committee initiated strict action to non-conforming members. Since Club decorum heads our priority list, may we, therefore, request esteemed members and their dependants to cooperate in preserving discipline in Club premises.

Birthday Card. We are regularly sending Birthday Card to all members well before their Birthday. The Card contains a tear-off coupon which is required to be handed over to the concerned waiter at the time of placing order for food/snacks, for availing 20% discount on the A-la-Card menu (not allowed for fixed party menu) till two weeks of the Birthday. It has been observed

that a very small number of members are availing this facility.

Financial obligation of members. The members have a personal obligation to pay Club dues timely in the form of Subscription (applicable to Permanent, Associate and Associate Dependant members) and promotion of sports and cultural activities, also applicable to Founder and Life members. It is a matter of serious concern that a large number of members do not clear their dues and due to lack of this obligation, we were constrained to terminate membership of 62 members. May we request the members to extend your valuable cooperation to help us in conceptualising, formulating, executing and coordinating all matters related to management of the establishment and all round development of the Club.

CLUB CIRCULAR SENT TO ALL MEMBERS REGARDING IMPORTANT DECISIONS OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE ON CLUB MEMBERSHIP

The Managing Committee in its meeting held on 05 July 2019, have taken following important decisions on Club membership :-

- ◆ Commencement of Associate Dependant Membership Scheme - II for 100 dependants of members (21-35 years) on first-cum-first served basis. The scheme shall close on 31 Dec 2019.
- ◆ Transfer of Membership allowed from brother to sister and sister to brother.
- ◆ Founder Membership (Fm) allowed to be transferred to legal heir without any charges (Free of cost).
- ◆ There is no change in other cases of Transfer of Membership including on demise of member.
